Position Overview:

Latinos En Spokane (LES) is seeking a dedicated Housing Specialist to join our Housing Initiative Project. The Housing Specialist will be crucial in assisting immigrant communities securing and maintaining stable housing by conducting assessments, developing housing plans, and providing comprehensive support for temporary and permanent housing.

Responsibilities:

- Focus on Housing Maintenance: Conduct regular inspections of each property under our master lease to ensure compliance with housing standards and address any maintenance issues promptly
- **Resource Navigation:** create and maintain a housing resource guide with affordable housing options in Spokane County.
- **Collaboration and Advocacy:** Work with landlords, housing providers, and community organizations to secure appropriate housing and advocate for clients' needs.
- **Ongoing Support:** Provide continuous support to help clients maintain stable housing, including education about their rights and responsibilities as tenants.
- **Record Maintenance:** Maintain accurate records of client interactions, housing plans, progress, room and rental payments.
- **Monitoring and Upkeep**: Oversee rental housing units, including collecting rent and managing tenant leases.
- **Research Housing Opportunities**: Identify potential housing options, including rooms and co-housing opportunities.
- **Technical Assistance:** Guide clients through housing processes, such as navigating leases, meeting requirements, and managing rent payments.



Qualifications:

- Bilingual proficiency in English and Spanish.
- High school diploma or equivalent required; bachelor's degree in social work, Human Services, or a related field preferred.
- Previous experience in housing assistance, case management, or working with migrants and asylum seekers is highly desirable.

- Proficient in maintaining accurate records and documentation.
